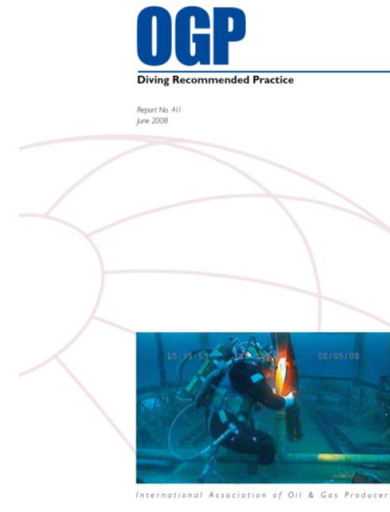

- Add nitrox and breathing gas purity to appendices
- Include Ship Husbandry as a definition and recognise industry initiatives – ADCI Ship husbandry –
- Expand FMEA

Ship Husbandry improvement initiative

- Utilise IDIF – ADCI/IMCA/IOGP
- Commonality of standards
- Improve Data collection
- Improve understanding of risk and control amongst key stakeholders
- Map out stakeholders
- Develop a white paper that assists with organisation and targeting resource
